PSA Design were commissioned by Brierkrete Limited to provide advice on highway matters and access proposals to support an outline planning application for a residential development on Catterall Gates Lane, Garstang. The development consists of up to 150 dwellings.

The access proposals included the design of a mini-roundabout, repositioning of a bus-stop, and the design of several T-junctions, all in accordance with Lancashire County Council specifications. The design incorporated 3no. speed tables to maintain slow speeds on the development.

PSA Design consulted directly with Lancashire County Council to ensure that their specifications were met. Consultation was also carried out with the local Parish Council regarding access to the parish hall and usage of the bus stop, and a full transport assessment was carried out.

PSA were involved in negotiations for the sale of the site, assisting the legal team on highway matters.

Taylor Woodrow/Bryant homes have now developed the site based on the access proposals.
