Work was completed in 2008.



The client required construction of a new office development for a brown field site at the Junction of the A59 and A565, Tarleton.

The new portalised framed buildings were built on a brown field site on the outskirts of Tarleton.

The building consists of load bearing masonry, partial steel portal frames, timber roof, ground bearing floor slabs and mezzanine floors for office storage space.

We supervised the ground investigation for the project and produced the interpretive report. Due to high levels of contamination we were also involved in various remediation strategies to satisfy planning conditions.

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
